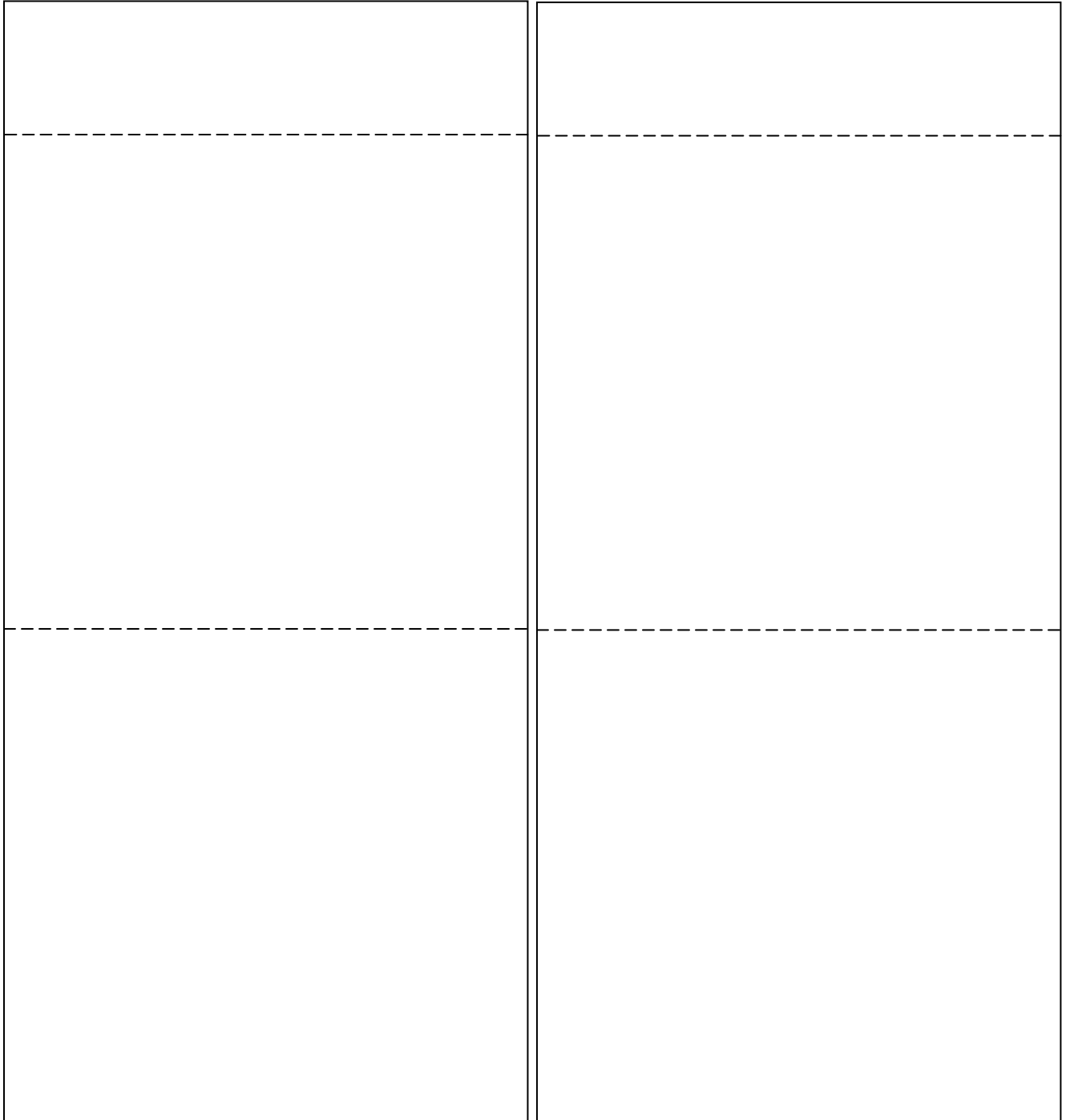


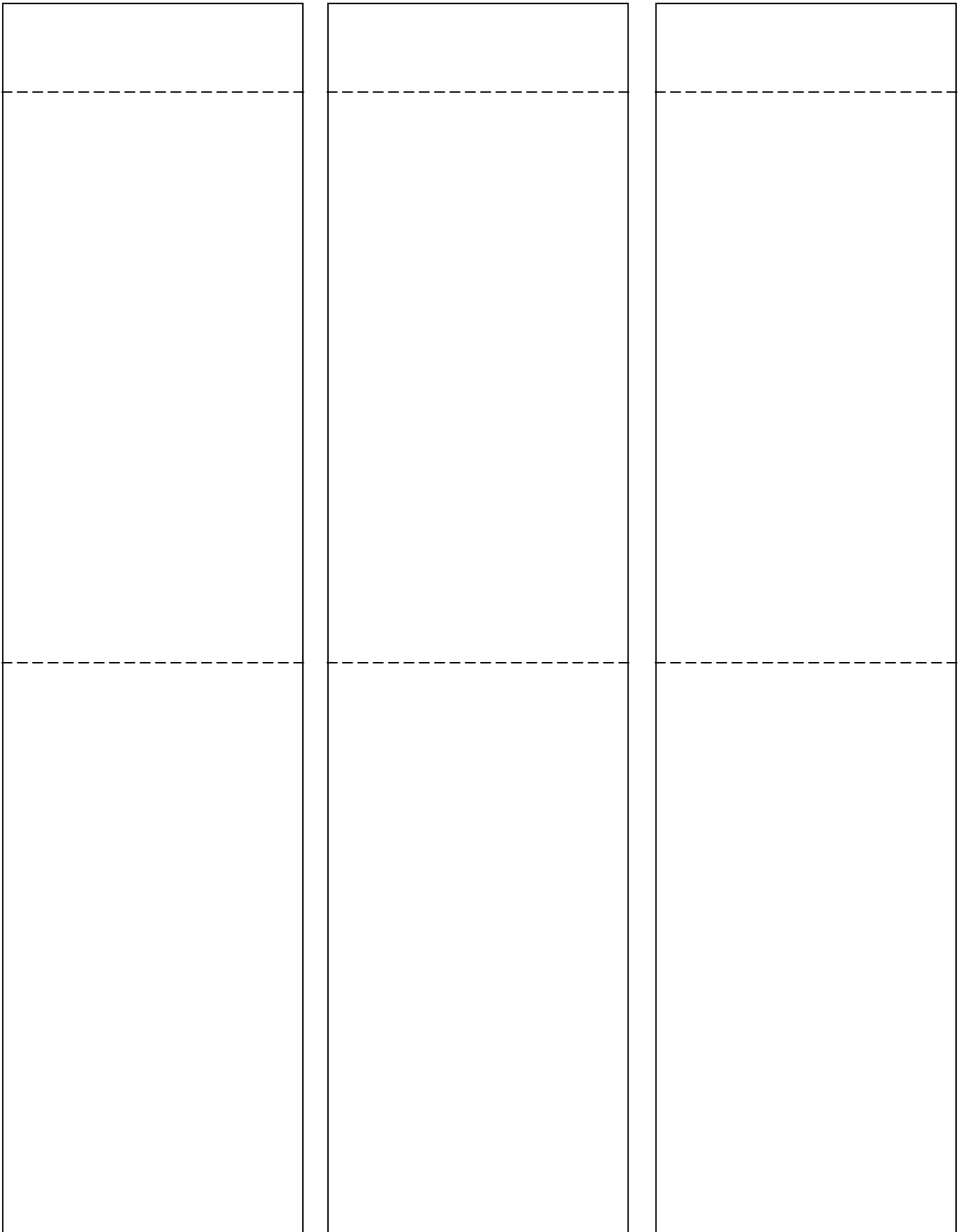

Compare and Contrast Matchbook

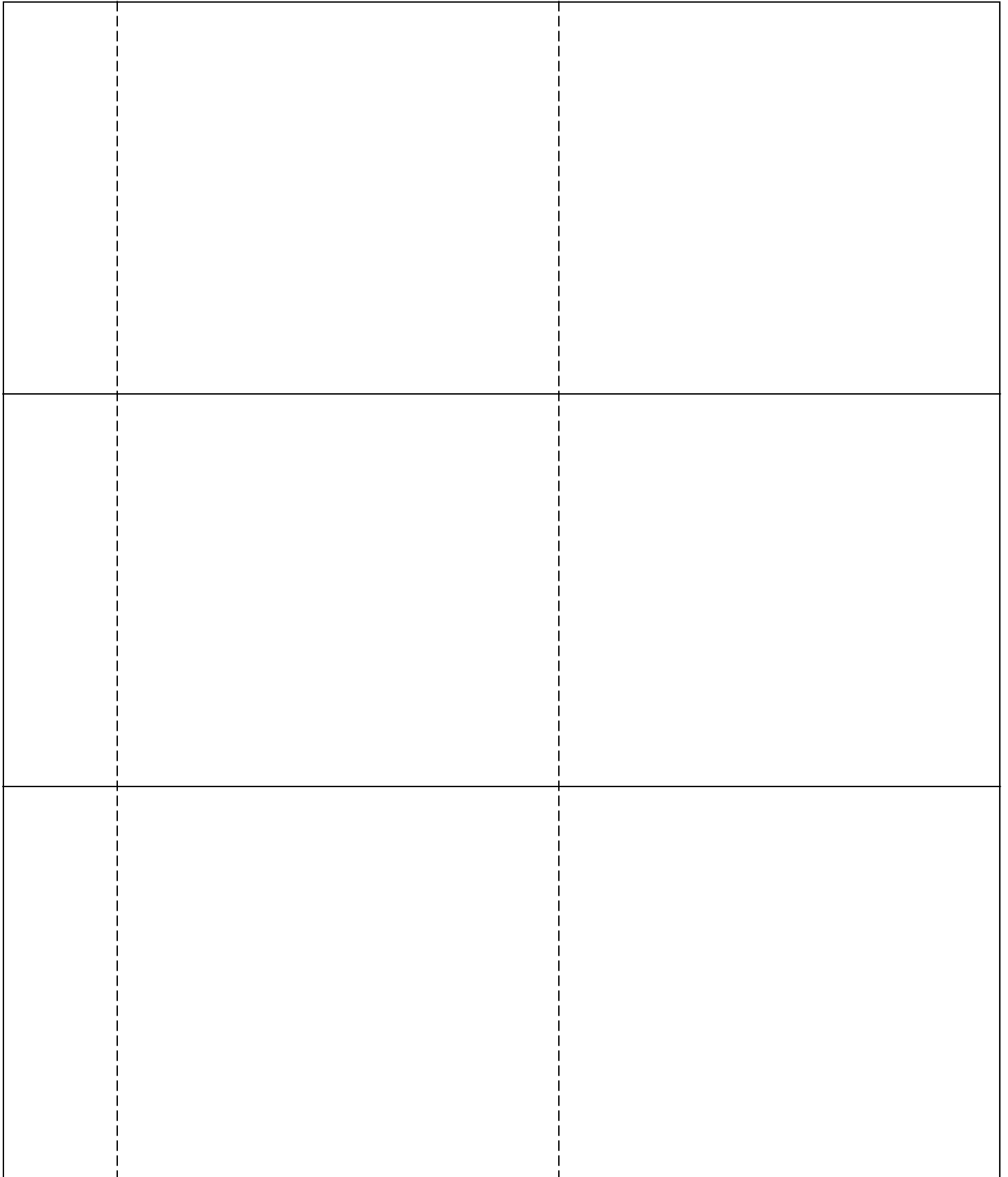

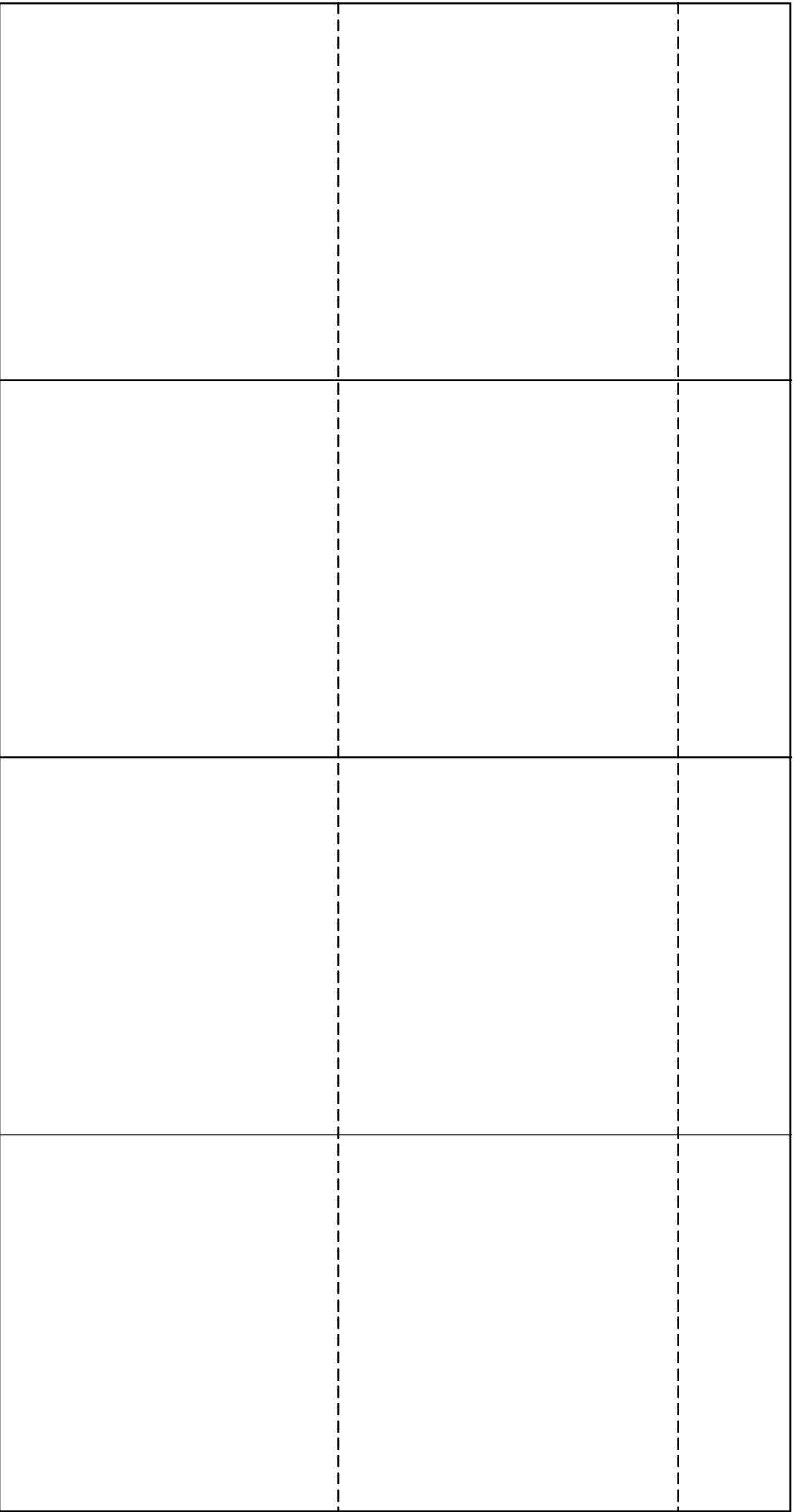

Cut on solid lines. Fold on dotted lines (matchbook style).



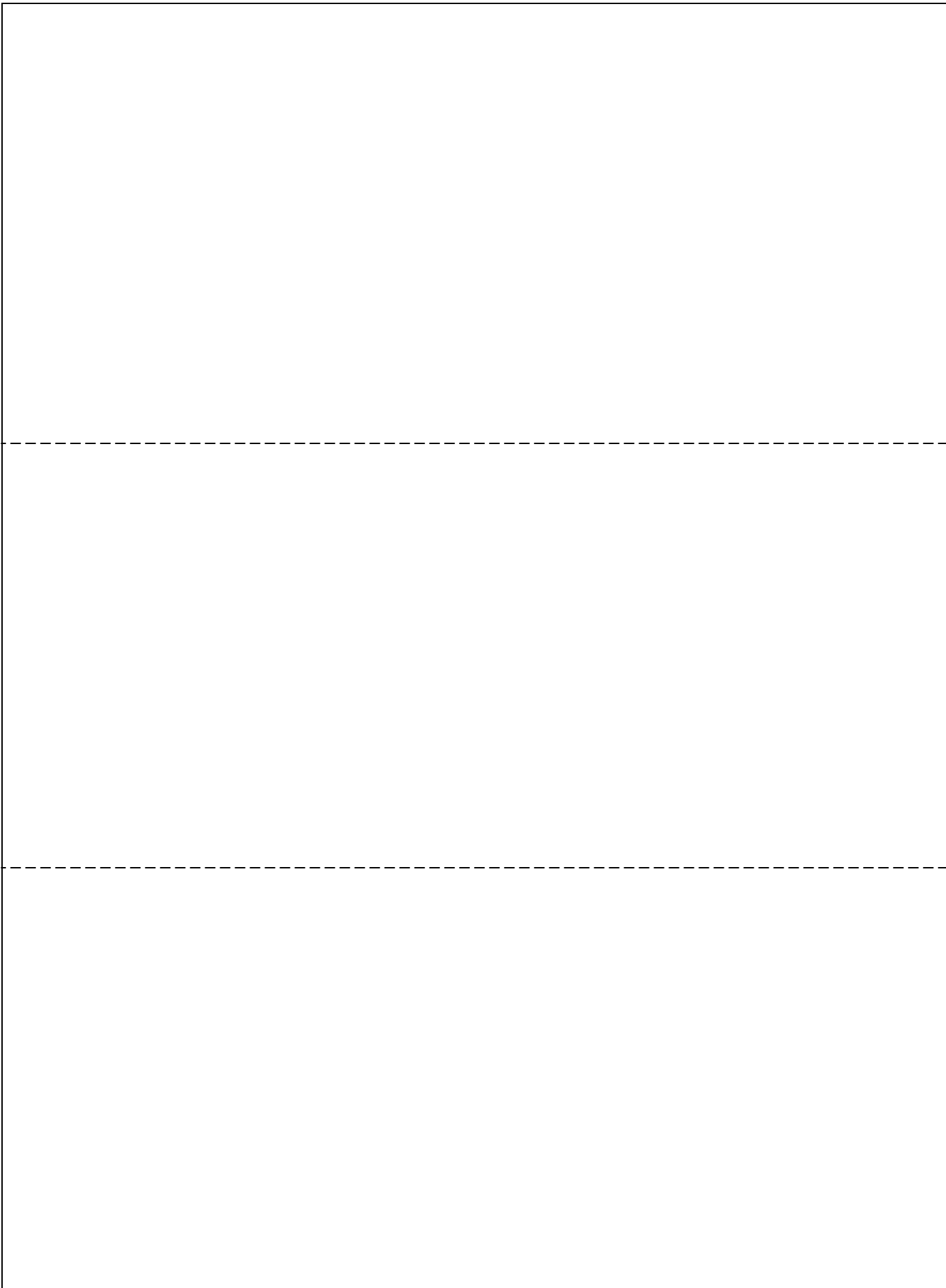
Cut on solid black lines. Fold books matchbook style.



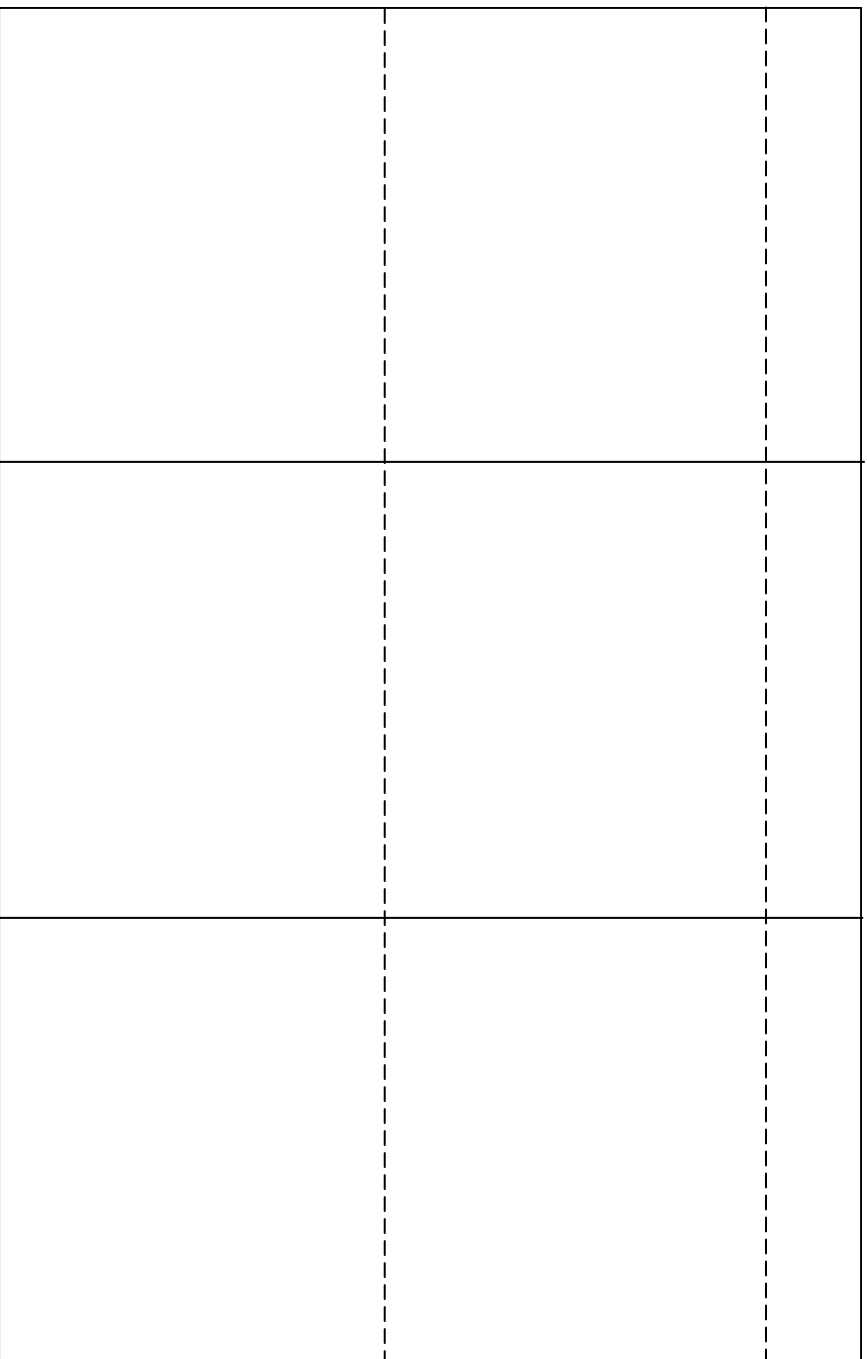
